

F1 POWERBOAT FESTIVAL A SUCCESS

The Free State Tourism Authority (FSTA) and Zam Entertainment left the Parys community gasping for air this past weekend, when it hosted the annual F1 Powerboat Lifestyle show.

Held at the majestic Parys Golf and Country Estate, the show lived up beyond its expectations and more according to FSTA communication officer Tshidiso Lerumo.

Lerumo said over the past years FSTA has strived to position the Free State province as an event destination with the view to grow domestic tourism grown.

According to the National Domestic Tourism Growth Strategy, event promotion and packaging for sports, music, lifestyle and cultural events is one of the pillars that underpin the domestic growth campaigns to ensure that there is growth within the industry.

FSTA Care Taker CEO, Louis Moahlodi, said the entity will continue to partner with event organisers around the province over the year to ensure that the entity address the tourism geographic spread and seasonality.

"This will also ensure that the FSTA respond to the challenge posed by the Domestic Tourism Growth Strategy that calls for growth in numbers of South African who visit their own country to learn and experience the world class destinations that are at their doorsteps," said Moahlodi.
