

Article sentiment on COVID-19




- * Most coverage on COVID-19 in SA remains **neutral in sentiment**, just reporting factually on the situation.
 - * Positive coverage (down from the day before and compared to negative) is about a good response as roads were virtually empty on the first day of lockdown; and institutions expressing support for government COVID-19 measures.
 - * Negative sentiment is about the impact of COVID-19 on business/the economy; exposure of service delivery failures; and certain violations of lockdown regulations.
